I have won, everything. Now it is just a matter of time while people go through legal processes.

As you know I have three ways forward, the campaign, overturning the intimidation charge and overturning the assault charge. I thought the last was going to be the most difficult but it turned out to be the easiest.

*So, let's start with the campaign.* The politicians I have spoken to have all been told about the convictions, and seen the evidence that proves you lied. It was all on a website, now deleted so you can't see it. That is why they spoke to me. I have had meetings with Nick Bourne, leader of the Conservative party in Wales, and I have prepared a report for the Welsh Assembly Conservative group on the campaign. Nick ensured they read it and they are pretty much on board. I have contacted many senior Conservatives in Wales and all approve of my work.

I have had meetings with Kirsty Williams, leader of the Liberal Democrats in Wales, and with her policy and research staff. I have met several other Lib Dem Ams and MPs. All have been very supportive.

I have had meetings or telephone meetings with several Plaid Cymru Ministers and AMs, all of whom have been very interested or very supportive including Elin Jones, Minister for rural affairs, Jocelyn Davis, Housing, Alun Ffred Jones, Heritage and Culture and Helen Mary Jones, deputy leader.

I have also spoken to Caerwyn Jones briefly about the campaign and have met Labours head of policy in Transport House, their headquarters in Cardiff. I have also met Plaid policy staff at their headquarters in Cardiff.

I have been in touch with Eric Pickles (he was chairman of the Conservative party at the time) and both Pickles and Cameron have indicated their support.

As I can get the support of a majority of AMs in the Assembly I am stoooping the campaign until after the election and will then work with them through the Assembly's processes from the introduction of my system.

I would like to show you the evidence I have of these meetings. You can also see letters from donors.

*The intimidation case.* You have already had the email about that but I am happy to show you all the evidence that will go before the court in due course.

*The assault charge.* This has been with the Criminal Cases Revue Commission (CCRC) for a couple of weeks now and been allocated its case number and case worker. The CCRC is a government body that exists to investigate miscarriages of justice and they are now looking at the assault case. I have also given them the background to the intimidation case and described my work and who I have had meetings with. It's going to be a very high profile case and this will get them lots of brownie points when my convictions are overturned. Just what a government organisation needs at a time of major cuts.
