Things are starting to pick up speed now with the campaign, and the personal side is well under control.

I had a long chat with PC Andrew Jones at Mach police house and told him exactly what I was up to (I took along examples of the correspondence I have had with politicians in Wales) and told him all about the changes of statement in court etc. etc. So there is no problem there and he can act as a witness for me if necessary. I made it very clear that I am trying to help you, but I didn't go into any detail about how I can get you out of the hole you are in. He doesn't need to know about that.

I also gave the BBC a call on Thursday, not Wednesday. As you know I always do things late. They are obviously very interested and gave me the contact details for their Welsh political correspondents. I told them I was a criminal. Makes it a bit more interesting, especially when there is an obvious miscarriage of justice involved.

I'm not going to push that for a couple of days yet as I want to use their interest to help me arrange some meetings around Wales. This will be done by working with other groups to do public meetings that will get us the volunteers we need. I'll be doing that over the weekend, although I have contacted some groups already. The Welsh Assembly petition, a publicity stunt, is on track and it is time to start contacting the party branches on Tuesday. The money for this last stage is now coming in, and I can probably stop fund raising this week.

None of this is good news for you but I really don't want to see you hurt. I will bend over backwards to help you. That is not going to be easy but it can be done providing it is done in a particular way. It is quite awkward to set this up and you'll understand why after you have spoken to me.

I want to meet you so that you can see the evidence of all that has been happening, all the meetings with party leaders and policy people etc, and so that I can explain my plans for getting you out of a difficult situation. Once that is done, once you understand what the situation is you can then decide how to handle it. After that you will never need to speak to me again, (unless you need some help in which case you can).

The problem is that I am going to have to cover some things up for you. I am willing to do that but the more people who know what I am up to the more likely it is that the story will leak and you won't look so good. That is why I don't want anyone to know about this and why I want to meet you alone, but in a public place so you feel safe. I will be in Llani on

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
